
City of Cypress Updates



Congratulations to the graduates of our 2022 Citizen's Academy! Sixteen dedicated Cypress residents just completed our six-week interactive course. From public safety to city finances and the decision-making process, participants went behind the scenes of our departments and met the dedicated staff who keep Cypress running. The new mixed-use development at the northwest corner of Katella Avenue and Winners Circle (across from Costco) continues to take shape! The development, called **Cypress Square**, will feature a brand new hotel, a 251-unit apartment building, a medical office building, and 24,000 square feet of retail space. **The retail portion of the site will include two new restaurants and a Trader Joe's, which plans to open by the end of the year.** The apartment building is currently under construction and will be complete by mid-2024. Construction of the hotel and medical office will start later this year. Stay tuned for updates on this exciting project!

BONO, KUBO AND THEIR PARTNERS: K-9 UNITS ON THE LINE OF DUTY



When it comes to tracking and searching for items, the Cypress Police Department has two units that have their colleagues beat by a nose, a K-9 nose that is.

Bono and **Officer Mermer** have been together since January 2020. Bono is a 3-year-old Belgian Shepherd who came to us all the way from the Netherlands, where he trained in police work.

Meanwhile, **Kubo** and **Officer Marshall** have been sidekicks since May 2018. Kubo is a 5-year-old German Shepherd from Slovakia, where he underwent two years of extensive training. Both Bono and Kubo specialize in handler protection, criminal apprehension, tracking, and searching for articles.

While they look pretty friendly and love meeting our residents, these units are highly skilled and are used to supplement police operations to locate and apprehend bad guys. Thank you Bono, Kubo, Officers Mermer and Marshall, for your fur-st class service!
