2023 CITIZEN'S ACADEMY






Public Safety Updates

HANDS-ONLY CPR

WHAT TO DO BEFORE HELP ARRIVES:



- Call 9-1-1
- Lay Person Face Up and Open Their Airway
- Kneel Near Person's Body
- Interlock Fingers and Place Heel of Hands Over Chest
- · Lock Elbows, Keep Arms Straight
- Push Hard and Fast (2 inches deep, 100-120 compressions per minute)
- Repeat Compressions Until Ambulance or First Responders Arrive







TO FIND A PULSE:

Place index and middle finger on wrist, at the base of the thumb. Count how many beats you feel in thirty seconds and multiple by two.

RESIDENTIAL POLLUTION PREVENTION AND REPORTING

Did you know that the water in our storm drains is not treated before it reaches the ocean and beaches? Luckily, simple actions can limit residential pollution:

Lawncare and Gardening: Pull weeds by hand or use non-toxic alternatives to traditional pesticides and fertilizers, recycle yard waste in green bins, and avoid wasteful irrigation methods.

Automotive Maintenance: Have your oil changed by a professional, clean up leaks and spills with absorbent materials, wash your car with biodegradable or phosphate-free cleaners, and divert water to grassy or planted areas.
