If you prefer to vote in person, the Cypress Community Center will host a Vote Center leading up to the election.

CITY TRANSITION TO DISTRICTS FOR CITY COUNCIL ELECTIONS **FIND YOUR DISTRICT!**



Starting this November, Cypress will transition to bydistrict elections, meaning voters will elect one Council Member to represent the district in which they live. The Council Member must reside in the same district and will be elected by the voters residing there.

For the upcoming election on November 5, 2024, residents in Districts 3 and 4 will vote for their Council Member. In 2026, residents in Districts 1, 2, and 5 will elect their respective Council Members. This sequence ensures that a Council Member will reside in each district during the two-year transition from at-large to by-district elections, while honoring the terms of Council Members elected in 2022.





Safe PARENT SUPPORT: HELPING PARENTS **NAVIGATE THE DIGITAL WORLD**

Open communication is essential to prepare your child for potential threats. Teach them how to report suspicious activity online.



POTENTIAL ONLINE THREATS:

ONLINE GAMING: Gaming platforms are ripe for cyber-bullying, hacked webcams, online predators, and terrorist radicalization.



POTENTIALLY DANGEROUS APPS: Malicious users may use apps to groom, bully, harass, gather personal information, or elicit photos. Review these and other potential dangers of online apps at SafeOC.com/parent-support.



DIRECT MESSAGES: Did you know some social platforms delete messages after they are sent? Your child may be receiving, or sending explicit, threatening, or inappropriate content without your knowledge.

KEEP YOUR TRICK-OR-TREATERS SAFE



Stick Together: Never trick-or-treat alone. Ensure that a responsible adult or a responsible teen accompanies each group of children.

Be Visible: If you're trick-or-treating after dark, make costumes and bags more visible by adding reflective tape or using glow sticks.

Safe Walking: Only cross streets at corners and look both ways before crossing and avoid running between parked cars.

Know the Route: Make sure to stay in familiar neighborhoods and only visit homes with porch lights on.

Check Treats: Instruct children not to eat any treats until they are home and you can inspect them.
